- Back to Class



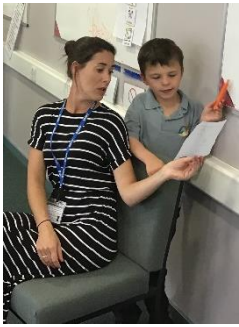
Kirby took a photo of everyone. Dani kindly took some more photos during the meeting.

Everyone thought this was a good idea.

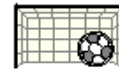


Finley also said he would like more Horse-riding and drew a picture on the whiteboard. Finley added more bus trips and park visits too.
